

# Youth Custodial Rule 101 Distribution of Youth Custodial Rules and compliance with legislation

Legislation referred to: <u>Young Offenders Act 1994</u>

#### 1. Purpose

Youth Custodial Rules generally undertake to provide rules for the management, control and security of youth detention centres, the management, control and security of detainees in those centres and the management of officers of the Department of Corrective Services in Western Australia employed in youth detention centres and other facilities under the control of Youth Custodial Services. Youth Custodial Rules 2012 take into account recent Legislation passed and amended since the previous version of Juvenile Custodial Rules were endorsed in 2008.

# 2. Scope

This Rule applies to all Youth Custodial Services staff, volunteers and contractors and should be read in conjunction with all relevant Rules, Standing Orders and Departmental Policies and Procedures.

#### 3. Legislation

Legislation impacting on the content of these Youth Custodial Rules includes, but is not limited to the following:

- Main legislation affecting the care of young offenders in detention centres:
  - The <u>Young Offenders Act 1994</u> including the <u>Young Offenders</u> <u>Regulations 1995</u>
- Other relevant legislation affecting the care of detainees in detention centres:

  - o Children's Court of Western Australia Act 1988
  - o <u>Community Protection (Offender Reporting) Act 2004</u>
  - o <u>Court Security and Custodial services Act 1999</u>
  - o <u>Inspector of Custodial Services Act 2003</u>
  - o <u>Victims of Crime Act 1994</u> s 4

# 4. Confidentiality

Staff shall not disclose or allow to be disclosed any Youth Custodial Rule designated for distribution to **Staff Only**, or any information contained therein to any detainee or other person without the prior approval of the Superintendent or their delegate.
